

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-01

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION TO DARKE COUNTY FOR THE CDBG COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ALLOCATION PROGRAM FOR THE FUNDING OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW MADISON WASHINGTON STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and the Ohio Department of Development, through the Darke County Commissioners, administers financial assistance to qualifying local communities with the CDBG Community Development Allocation Program.

WHEREAS, the Village of New Madison desires financial assistance through the CDBG Community Development Allocation Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the forgoing, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Madison, Darke County, Ohio, as follows:


SECTION ONE: That the Village of New Madison approves filing an application to the Darke County Commissioners CDBG Community Development Allocation Program.

SECTION TWO: That the Village Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to file an application with the Darke County Commissioners CDBG Community Development Allocation Program and to provide all information and documentation required.

SECTION THREE: That the Village of New Madison does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project under the terms and conditions of the Darke County CDBG Community Development Allocation Program.

SECTION FOUR: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure so as to meet the deadline for the CDBG Grant Allocation Application and shall therefore take effect immediately upon its adoption.
