ORDINANCE 2024-01

AN ORDINANCE VACATING BAKER STREET

WHEREAS, Council has previously adopted Ordinance 15-1976 on February 12, 1977 providing for the vacation of Baker Street between Lots 155 and Lots 156; and

WHEREAS, that the Village Solicitor was to record said Ordinance with the County Recorder, but same was not done; and

WHEREAS, this oversight has resulted in confusion in the County offices;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of New Madison, Darke County, Ohio, as follows:

Section One: The Council previously found that the petition signed by the owner(s) of the property abutting Baker Street, between Lot 155 and Lot 156, and the Village should no longer be designated as a street.


Section Two: The Council has further found that there is good cause for vacation of said street area as requested, and that such vacation of the portion of the street will not be detrimental to the general interests and ought to be made.

Section Three: The land located between Lot 155 and Lot 156 being approximately 49.50 feet by 132.00 feet is hereby remised and released to the owner of said Lots.


Section Four: The Fiscal Officer is instructed to incorporate the attached map of this area, to this legislation of Council in vacating said portion of the street and to cause an authenticated copy of this Ordinance along with said attached map to be made of record in the Office of the Darke County Recorder.

Section Five: The Fiscal Officer is further directed to notify the Darke County Auditor of the vacation by presenting an authenticated copy of this Ordinance.
